Quorum: (15) members were present. A motion was made by Argjent Kala, second by Brandon Jones and passed to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as printed.

Communications:

A letter was read from President Rolando announcing a June RAP Session in Atlantic City to explain the tentative agreement.

New Business:

- ❖ President Daniels reported that the May LCPF drive ended with 182 members contributing \$17,436. Checks totaled \$3,169 with automatic payroll and annuity raising \$14,267. Drawings for the two sweepstakes prizes were then held. Brandon Jones drew the first prize winner of \$300 who was Meriden retiree Dennis Redican. Billie-Jo Romano then drew the second prize winner of \$200 who was Middletown retiree Maurice Robitaille, Jr.
- ❖ NALC's Food Drive was May 13th. Branch 20's 31 offices collected 125,653 pounds of food.
- ❖ There was no further estimates to replace the meeting hall door. Motion by Kate Tavernier, second by Mitch Dingle and passed to have Norke Builders replace door for \$2,700.
- ❖ President Daniels reviewed tentative national agreement. He advised that ballots for ratification would be sent out June 19th. Motion by Kate Tavernier, second by Argjent Kala and passed to send two officers to the National RAP session on the new tentative agreement with all expenses paid.
- ❖ Motion by Billie-Jo Romano, second by Robert Ponzio and passed to pay lost time, mileage and lunch for all stewards' and officers' for the June 28th stewards' meeting.
- ❖ Motion by Kate Tavernier, second by Robert Ponzio and passed to purchase pre-paid fuel oil for office at \$2.19 a gallon totaling \$1,843.
- ❖ President Daniels reviewed a Meriden forced overtime grievance that the "B" team resolved favorably for the union and paid 27 carriers.
- ❖ Motion by Billie-Jo Romano, second buy Brandon Jones and passed to suspend the July and August union meetings.
