Quorum (14) members were present. A motion was made by Charles Pendola, second by Norman St. Arnauld and passed to accept the minutes of the March meeting as printed.

Communications:

An audit report of Branch 20's books dated April 3, 2019 was received from Trustees Tim Thibault and Charles Pendola. Trustee Jolanda Velez-Ruberte' was absent from the audit. All accounts were found to be in good order for the period of October 1, 2018 through January 31, 2019.

A notice of Branch 86's annual MDA Golf Tournament was received requesting a donation. A letter was received from the NALC Disaster Relief Foundation and NALC President Fred Rolando thanking the branch for our donation of \$1,000 to the Foundation.

A letter was received from the wife of deceased letter carrier John Tynan who worked in the Middletown office for 40 years asking if she could contribute to the LCPF in memory of her late husband. President Daniels responded with a letter thanking her for her interest in making this important donation but had to tell her that only active and retired letter carriers could make contributions to the Political Fund.

New Business:

The Food Drive is May 11th. NALC Headquarters has sent out posters to all offices with a copy of a letter from the USPS in which PMG Megan Brennan expresses her support for the 2019 Food Drive and requests the full support of all USPS managers for this year's Food Drive.

In response to a question asked at the March meeting regarding a CCA's discipline record when they are converted to regular President Daniels advised that after checking with the NBA's office that it was determined that the discipline follows the CCA into their career position.

A motion was made by Kate Tavernier, second by Norman St. Arnauld and passed to make a donation of \$100 to Branch 86's annual MDA golf tournament.
